Numbers to 100

The chart is the map. Down is ten more, across is one more.

One row of the chart

21	22	23	24	25	26	27	28	29	30
31	32	33	34	35	36	37	38	39	40

23 and 33 are one under the other. 33 is ten more.

The same numbers on a line

Every long tick is a ten. The arrow is at 35.



Fill the chart > Count in steps > Ten more or less > Read the line

Moving down the chart adds ten. Only the first digit changes.

Moving right adds one. 39 to 40 turns the corner.

Counting by tens from 4 works too: 14, 24, 34.

Say the numbers out loud while pointing at the chart.

The chart is worth pinning up. It answers most questions.
